



**Georgia 2022 Enacted District Analysis**

The tables in this document are analysis of the Georgia Congressional, State Senate, and State House of Representatives district maps adopted in 2022. The data descriptions below explain the headings used in each table. Note that the data definitions of some headings, notably Black Voting Age Population and Asian Voting Age Population are different than those used by FDGA and the Princeton Gerrymandering Project to create benchmarks for the evaluation of proposed maps. For this reason, the demographic analysis in this document cannot be compared to the previous benchmark study of the proposed maps.
